

ETHNIC TRANCE TRIO

The trio was founded during summer 2015 on a big journey through russia. It started out as a Duo between Gudimir on gusli and Simon on clarinet, and later on drummer Marc joined them.

Whether in opera houses, jazz clubs, small theaters, cinemas or at open air festivals, they always fascinated their audiences.

Gusli is one of the oldest russian string instruments - his roots go back to ancient times - and Gudimir (Maxim Anukhin) from St. Petersburg is the most important living virtuoso on that instrument.

The music consists elements from russian folk music as well as some rhythmic and harmonic structures from indian music.

Combined with western concepts from jazz and classical music, stimulating sometimes hypnotic sounding worlds. Characteristic of this trio is the lower tuning of the instruments (A = 432 Hz) , which results in warm and gentle sound, laying out an esoteric, metaphysical mood.
